

Directions to Best Western in Massapequa Park, NY

FROM ALL POINTS SOUTH

Take Route I-95 (NJ Turnpike) north to Exit 13.

Get off at Exit 13, pay turnpike toll, and follow signs for Route 278 / Goethals Bridge.

Go over the Goethals Bridge. Once on the other side you will be on the Staten Island Expressway (Rt. 278) headed east. Welcome to the NYC Borough of Staten Island.

Another toll. This time, for the Goethals Bridge you just crossed. Toll is \$6 – but will be free going home.

Take Staten Island Expressway (278) for about 7 miles, straight to the Verrazano Bridge. When you see the toll booths, get to the right. (They still have the booths, but there is no toll in this direction. Going the other way will be \$9). Stay to the right and follow the large sign for Belt Parkway – It usually says to take the lower level. If you wind up on the upper level, don't worry. You will have an exit from the left lane for the Belt Parkway on that level too.

Once on the bridge, get into the far left lane. The exit for the Belt Parkway will only be from the far left lane. NYC is off to your left in the distance, but you will have a better view on the way home. Don't crash into the divider.

Take exit for "Belt Parkway East / Kennedy Airport".

Exit the bridge (great view of the bridge here as you descend next to it) and merge with the Belt Parkway along the water. Welcome to the NYC borough of Brooklyn.

At 3.5 miles, you will see the remnants of Coney Island's famed parachute drop in the distance off to your right.

At approximately 16.5 miles, you will pass Kennedy (JFK) Airport. Welcome to the NYC Borough of Queens.

At Exit 25A, bear left as the parkway splits and follow the sign for "Southern State Parkway / Eastern Long Island".

You are now on Southern (State) Parkway.

Take Exit 28A South – Rt. 135 / Seaford. Be careful, as this is a sharp exit ramp.

Go south on Route 135. Your second exit will be for Route 27 (Sunrise Highway). Take the exit for Sunrise Highway going East.

Once on Sunrise Highway, the elevated Long Island railroad tracks will be on your left. After 1.9 miles you will see a red bell tower, also on your left. This is the Massapequa Park train station. The

Best Western will come up on your right after 3 more traffic lights. (Immediately before the Hess service station.).

Welcome to Massapequa Park.

FROM NEW ENGLAND REGION

Take the New England Thruway (Rt. I-95) south to New York. When you cross into New York State from Connecticut, the exit numbers will start counting down again, starting with Exit 18.

At Exit 7A, follow sign for Throgg's Neck Bridge / Rt. 295. DO NOT follow signs for Rt. 95 south anymore.

When you get to the bridge toll, use a "cash" toll lane. Toll will be \$4.50 each way.

Proceed across bridge and keep going straight. Once across the bridge, the road becomes the Clearview Expressway (Rt. 295). Welcome to the NYC borough of Queens.

Continue on the Clearview Expressway to Exit 4E-W (might be just 4) for Rt. 495 / Long Island Expressway. Bear left on the exit ramp following 4E for Rt. 495 East and follow the sign for Eastern Long Island / Riverhead.

Now going east on Rt. 495, take it to Exit 44s (Exit 44 south) for Rt. 135 / Seaford.

Once on Rt. 135, travel 8.7 miles and you will see signs for NY Route 27 (Sunrise Highway). Take the exit for Sunrise Highway going East.

Once on Sunrise Highway, the elevated Long Island railroad tracks will be on your left. At about 2 miles you will see a red bell tower, also on your left. This is the Massapequa Park train station. The Best Western will come up on your right after 3 more traffic lights. (Immediately before the Hess service station.).

Welcome to Massapequa Park.

FROM ALL POINTS NORTH OR NORTHWEST

Take NY Route 17 south to New York State Thruway at Harrison, NY, if necessary. Otherwise, just head south on Route 87 / New York State Thruway towards New York City.

Continue south on NYS Thruway (87) over the Tapanzee Bridge. The Thruway exits will count down to 1 and then reset back to 18 as the highway now becomes the Major Deegan Expressway (87) shortly after the town of Yonkers.

Take Exit 7N-S (might be just 7) for Cross Bronx Expressway. Once on the ramp you want to stay right and follow Exit 7N to go north on Rt. 95. This part of Rt. 95 is called the Cross Bronx Expressway. Welcome to the NYC borough of The Bronx.

After passing Exit 5B, watch for and follow any signs for the Throgg's Neck Bridge. Once you see a sign for Throgg's Neck Bridge, DO NOT follow Route 95 north anymore. Follow signs for Rt. 295 – Throgg's Neck Bridge / Clearview Expressway.

Use a “cash” toll lane for the bridge. Toll will be \$4.50 each way.

Proceed across bridge and keep going straight. Once across the bridge, the road becomes the Clearview Expressway (Rt. 295). Welcome to the NYC borough of Queens.

Continue on the Clearview Expressway to Exit 4E-W (might be just 4) for Rt. 495 / Long Island Expressway. Bear left on the exit ramp following 4E for Rt. 495 East and follow the sign for Eastern Long Island / Riverhead.

Now going east on Rt. 495, take it to Exit 44s (Exit 44 south) for Rt. 135 / Seaford.

Once on Rt. 135, travel 8.7 miles and you will see signs for NY Route 27 (Sunrise Highway). Take the exit for Sunrise Highway going East.

Once on Sunrise Highway, the elevated Long Island railroad tracks will be on your left. At about 2 miles you will see a red bell tower, also on your left. This is the Massapequa Park train station. The Best Western will come up on your right after 3 more traffic lights. (Immediately before the Hess service station.).

Welcome to Massapequa Park.

FROM ALL POINTS WEST

Make your way to Route 80 and start heading east.

Pass through PA and NJ.

Route 80 will end at Route 95 near New York City. Follow signs for the George Washington Bridge as you take Rt. 95 north.

Use a “Cash” lane to pay the bridge toll. Toll will be \$6.00 – but free going home

Use upper or lower level of GW Bridge. You want to stay on Rt. 95 as you go under Manhattan. Follow signs for the Cross Bronx Expressway.

Route 95 becomes the Cross Bronx Expressway. Welcome to the NYC Borough of The Bronx.

After passing Exit 5B, watch for and follow any signs for the Throgg's Neck Bridge. Once you see a sign for Throgg's Neck Bridge, DO NOT follow Route 95 north anymore. Follow signs for Rt. 295 – Throgg's Neck Bridge / Clearview Expressway.

Use a “cash” toll lane for the bridge. Toll will be \$4.50 each way.

Proceed across bridge and keep going straight. Once across the bridge, the road becomes the Clearview Expressway (Rt. 295). Welcome to the NYC borough of Queens.

Continue on the Clearview Expressway to Exit 4E-W (might be just 4) for Rt. 495 / Long Island Expressway. Bear left on the exit ramp following 4E for Rt. 495 East and follow the sign for Eastern Long Island / Riverhead.

Now going east on Rt. 495, take it to Exit 44s (Exit 44 south) for Rt. 135 / Seaford.

Once on Rt. 135, travel 8.7 miles and you will see signs for NY Route 27 (Sunrise Highway). Take the exit for Sunrise Highway going East.

Once on Sunrise Highway, the elevated Long Island railroad tracks will be on your left. At about 2 miles you will see a red bell tower, also on your left. This is the Massapequa Park train station. The Best Western will come up on your right after 3 more traffic lights. (Immediately before the Hess service station.).

Welcome to Massapequa Park.

RETURN TRIPS

TO ALL POINTS SOUTH

Take Sunrise highway 2 miles west to Rt. 135 north.

Take Exit 4W for Southern (State) Parkway west.

Take Southern (State) Parkway, past Exit 13 and follow sign to left for Belt Parkway. Now on Belt Parkway.

Take Belt Parkway to Exit 3 for the Verrazano Bridge. Stay in the right lane as you go up the ramp and then bear right for the upper level.

Nice view of Manhattan way off in the distance on the right. Left of the skyscrapers and slightly closer you may see a tiny light green object, which is the Statue of Liberty.

Pay the \$9 toll at a cash toll booth. You are now on the Staten Island Expressway (287).

Take the Staten Island Expressway (278) for about 7 miles straight to the Goethals Bridge. Pay toll, and cross over the bridge in the left lane.

After the bridge, follow the exit sign to the left for the New Jersey Turnpike (95). Get a turnpike ticket and follow signs to the right for Rt. 95 South.

Have a safe trip home.

TO NEW ENGLAND REGION

Take Sunrise highway 2 miles west to Rt. 135 north.

Take Route 135 to Exit 13W for Long Island Expressway (Rt. 495) west.

Take LIE (Rt. 495) to Exit 27N-S and follow signs for 27N - Clearview Expressway (Rt. 295) / Throgg's Neck Bridge north.

Now on Clearview Expressway (295), take it straight over the Throgg's Neck Bridge. Pay cash toll (\$4.50) and follow signs to right for Route 95 North.

Have a safe trip home.

TO ALL POINTS NORTH OR NORTHWEST

Take Sunrise highway 2 miles west to Rt. 135 north.

Take Route 135 to Exit 13W for Long Island Expressway (Rt. 495) west.

Take LIE (Rt. 495) to Exit 27N-S and follow signs for 27N - Clearview Expressway (Rt. 295) / Throgg's Neck Bridge north.

Now on Clearview Expressway (295), take it straight over the Throgg's Neck Bridge. Pay cash toll (\$4.50) and follow signs to left for Route 95 South – George Washington Bridge.

You are now on the Cross Bronx Expressway (95). Take it to Exit 1C and follow signs for Major Deegan – Route 87 north.

Now on Major Deegan (87) north will eventually become NY State Thruway (87). Continue over the Tappansee Bridge and either hook up with Route 17 at Exit 16 (Harriman, NY) or continue northbound towards Albany.

Have a safe trip home.

TO ALL POINTS WEST

Take Sunrise highway 2 miles west to Rt. 135 north.

Take Route 135 to Exit 13W for Long Island Expressway (Rt. 495) west.

Take LIE (Rt. 495) to Exit 27N-S and follow signs for 27N - Clearview Expressway (Rt. 295) / Throgg's Neck Bridge north.

Now on Clearview Expressway (295), take it straight over the Throgg's Neck Bridge. Pay cash toll (\$4.50) and follow signs to left for Route 95 South – George Washington Bridge.

You are now on the Cross Bronx Expressway (95). Continue straight on this for about 7 miles right over the George Washington Bridge. No toll this way. Stay on Rt. 95 South.

Then follow any signs you see for Route 80. Do not follow any more signs for Rt. 95 south.

Have a safe trip home.
